

**Consent form to be completed by parents for nursery year \_\_\_\_\_**  
to agree to **language support at nursery (SPATZ)** provided by  
the state of Baden-Württemberg

Dear Parents,

Here at our nursery, \_\_\_\_\_,  
we would like to take advantage of funding being offered by the state of Baden-Württemberg for additional language support at nursery.

The aim of the "Grants for language support for children in need of extra help across all day care facilities (SPATZ Directive)" funding programme is to provide children who require extra language assistance with dedicated language support during their time at nursery through various dedicated means that go beyond the scope of the language support usually offered at this stage of education.

The Ministry of Culture, Youth and Sports has made L-Bank, Baden-Württemberg's very own state bank, responsible for organising the funding process. You can access the corresponding documentation at [www.l-bank.de/SPATZ](http://www.l-bank.de/SPATZ).

According to our assessment, we believe that your child would benefit from additional support with their language development. On that basis, we have identified a need for extra, group-based language support. We will be happy to discuss this further with you in person if you wish.

We would be delighted for your child to have the chance to benefit from dedicated additional language support at our nursery. Before we can apply for and be awarded a grant for this from the state, we need to ensure that certain conditions have been met. One of these involves asking parents to consent to their children being involved in the initiative.

We would therefore like to ask you to sign a consent form indicating that you are happy for your child to receive this support. We can guarantee that your child's personal details will not be passed on externally during the application process and that the provisions of the State Data Protection Act of Baden-Württemberg apply here.

Thank you very much in advance for providing us with your consent.

## Consent:

- I hereby give my consent for my child, \_\_\_\_\_, to benefit from additional language support funded by the state of Baden-Württemberg at nursery (SPATZ). I understand that there is no obligation to take part in this initiative.
- I hereby agree that the nursery may pass on my child's name and date of birth to the Baden-Württemberg state bank, Landeskreditbank Baden-Württemberg - Förderbank (L-Bank), as required for the purpose of applying for a grant to fund this additional language support.
- Your child's data will generally only ever be processed by the nursery. Your child's data might be passed on to the Baden-Württemberg state bank, Landeskreditbank Baden-Württemberg - Förderbank (L-Bank), but only within the scope of a spot check. L-Bank requires the specified details in order to complete the task of checking eligibility criteria as it has been assigned to it. I am aware that my child will not be able to benefit from additional language support if I do not provide my consent here.

There is no obligation to provide consent and consent can be revoked at any time. It is also possible to revoke only part of the consent expressed above. Revoking consent will not have any impact on the lawfulness of the processing of any personal data that took place on the basis of consent having been given before the consent was revoked. There are no disadvantages to be suffered by not providing consent or by revoking consent.

The Ministry of Culture, Youth and Sports is the authority responsible for processing personal data.

Personal data will be processed on the basis of your consent having been given.

Personal data will continue to be stored after the child has stopped being provided with the language support for legal reasons but will later be deleted.

You have the right to be informed by the nursery about your personal data as well as the right to rectification, the right to erasure and the right to restrict processing. Furthermore, you have the right to object to the processing of your data and the right to data portability. You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority for data protection, the Baden-Württemberg State Officer for Data Protection and Freedom of Information.

1 All guardians must sign this form in all cases with the exception of a situation in which the parents live apart and the child usually lives with just one parent with the consent of the other parent or as the result of a court decision. In this case, the signature of the parent with whom the child lives shall be sufficient.

2 There is no need to return this (signed) form if consent is not being given.

The responsible body shall retain the consent form and shall be required to present it to L-Bank upon request.
